

Fall 2018 and Winter 2019 Program Minimum Requirements and Session Fees

CANSKATE MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS AND SESSION FEES

We offer CanSkate three days a week. The listed CanSkate registration fees include both ice time and coaching. Skaters must be at least 3 years of age and are able to participate independently.

Canskaters are required to have their own skates and their own CSA-approved hockey or skating helmet. Rentals of ice skates and helmets are NOT available from Hillcrest Centre during Riley Park Canskate lesson times. Skaters are also required to wear mittens/gloves for warmth and protection. We recommended skaters to dress warmly and wear long pants and a sweater and/or jacket.

Program Pricing and Discounts

Registration Fees for Canskate:

- **Tuesdays** – \$165 for Fall only (15 weeks); \$110 for Winter only (10 weeks)
- **Thursdays** – \$165 for Fall only (15 weeks); \$110 for Winter only (10 weeks)
- **Saturdays** - \$154 for Fall only (14 weeks); \$121 for Winter only (11 weeks)

If you register for

- **Two** days a week, receive a **10% discount**.
- **Three** times a week, receive a **15% discount**

As you register, you will see a unit cost displayed per program session. Appropriate discounts will be applied when you complete your registration and check out.

ADDITIONAL FEES

As we are starting a new skating year, the following fees will also be automatically added to each individual registration:

- **\$35.65 Skate Canada Membership and Safe Sport Initiative Fee** payable once to Skate Canada (valid from September 1, 2018 to August 31, 2019)
- **\$10 RPFSC Administration Fee** (payable once from September 1, 2018 to August 31, 2019)

Enrollment in the Winter session is available now with a Fall registration. Winter ONLY lessons (without registering in the Fall session) will be available on Monday, December 3, 2018.
