## **Minimum Program Requirements and Registration Fees for CanSkate**

### **CanSkate Minimum Requirements and Registration Fees**

CanSkate lessons are offered two (2) times during the week. Skaters must be at least three (3) years of age and be able to participate independently.

Skaters are required to bring their own skates and helmets. Skate and helmet rentals will not be available during our lessons. CSA approved hockey helmets must be worn at all times (as per the Skate Canada Helmet Use Policy). Skaters should dress warmly and clothing should allow free range of motion. Gloves or mittens must be worn to protect the skater's hands if he/she falls, as well as for warmth. Skaters who are not wearing CSA approved hockey helmets will not be permitted to skate.
